## TRANSPORTATION TO TYSONS CORNER, VA

### Airline Transportation

- **Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD)** – approximately 15 miles West
  - This hotel does not provide shuttle service
  - Estimated taxi fare: \$35 USD (one way)
  - Alternate transportation: A La Carte Limousine; fee: \$50 USD (one way); reservation required
  - Driving Directions: Follow the Dulles Airport access road to i-495. From i-495 take exit 47, route 7 west Leesburg Pike/Tysons Corner. Stay in the right lane and make a right onto Towers Crescent Drive and right into our parking lot.
- **Ronald Regan Washington National Airport (DCA)** – approximately 16 miles NorthWest
  - This hotel does not provide shuttle service
  - Estimated taxi fare: \$35 USD (one way)
  - Alternate transportation: A La Carte Limousine; fee: \$50 USD (one way); reservation required
  - Driving Directions: Take the George Washington memorial parkway to the Capital Beltway, i-495. Follow the signs to Virginia. Stay on i-495 to exit 47, route 7 west Leesburg Pike/Tysons corner. Stay in the right lane and make a right onto Towers Crescent Drive and right into our parking lot.
- **Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport (BWI)** – approximately 45 miles
  - This hotel does not provide shuttle service
  - Estimated taxi fare: \$85 USD (one way)
  - Alternate transportation: Washington Flyer; fee: \$75 USD (one way)
  - Driving Directions: Take 95 south to 495 west/south to Northern VA Exit 47A (Route 7 West) off Capital Beltway.
